Motion by Alder Milton Cashman to approve minutes of the March 21, 2016 Common Council meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Alder Sara Strang. Motion carried.

Motion by Alder Milton Cashman to approve a request from Wisconsin River Trail to close Kansas Street in front of the Fire Station and School District Bus Barn on Saturday, May 7th, from 8:00 AM to Noon, for their annual Bike Safety Program. Motion seconded by Alder Brenda Kalish. Motion carried.

Motion by Alder Milton Cashman to approve request from Wisconsin River Trail to close the City Parking Lot north of Double K's and to close Wisconsin Avenue from Double K's south to the intersection of Oak Street and Wisconsin Avenue on Saturday, May 14th, from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM for the "Taste of Boscobel." Motion by Alder Steve Fritz to approve a special offer from Town & Country Sanitation to provide a Spring clean-up for the City for \$1,000; a savings of \$5,000.
